Terms of Reference

Trainee Knowledge Mobilization Stipend

Details

- Funding is available to support trainees in rheumatology clinical and health outcomes research degrees to disseminate their research products

Funding

- A minimum of four (4) awards are available annually
- The maximum amount awarded per trainee per year is \$1,500

Eligibility

- Trainee (post-doctoral fellow, graduate student, or undergraduate student) of a McCaig Institute for Bone and Joint Health Full or Associate member, engaged in clinical and health outcomes rheumatology research
- The research product is the result of trainee activities conducted at the McCaig Institute for Bone and Joint Health

Use of funds

- Materials required for knowledge mobilization activities, inclusive of professional figure and presentation slide development, poster printing, reports for community, online dissemination fees etc.
- Publication fees, including print, colour figure fees, open access, and article processing charges
- Note that this stipend does not cover travel for presentations; please refer to the Trainee Travel Stipend

Dates

- Applications for funding or requests for cost-recovery will be accepted on an ongoing basis

Accountability

Trainees are asked to provide

- Copies of any receipts or invoices for expenses to the A.J.E. Child Chair research office
- Funding acknowledgement within associated presentations, publications, or knowledge mobilization activities
